

If you are an EEA/EFTA citizen who intends to work in Iceland for less than 3 months and your employer will be paying wage related fees due to your employment in the country, you need to contact a relevant public authority that needs a system ID number for their own purposes, regarding the application of a system ID number. You cannot apply for a system ID yourself but you do need to request an appropriate public authority to apply for you. A system ID number does not grant you any rights in Iceland and does not confirm your right to residency in the country.

If you are staying for more than three months you must contact the offices of Registers Iceland.

If you are not an EEA/EFTA citizen you must contact the Directorate of Immigration.
